



Minimize Exposure



Consider **everything** contaminated unless you disinfected it recently or no one has been there: clothes, surfaces, common touch items, arms...

When possible, shower & change clothes @ work

Wash work clothes only with an additive in warmest water

Remember to clean car seats, steering wheel, shift knob, handles, pedal & "gear" area & any thing touched

Immune Response



Sleep regularly even if you have to give up something else. Go for 7-8 hours; nap prn

Eat Well – including fruits & vegetables if prediabetic/diabetic keep blood sugar in check

Consult your PCP or Medical Director before adding supplements or medications – zinc?

Get fresh air & activity. Have fun!

If someone @ home is @ risk - consider alternate plan

STAYING HEALTHY - BODY



Dose - how much virus is needed for illness

Minimize (avoid) exposure in all possible ways - on & off duty; Be mindful & have a plan

Public Safety & HCWs are at 1 risk due to repeat or continuous exposure

Keep your immune response at a high level

Monitor closely for signs of illness

STAYING HEALTHY - MIND



Leave work at work. Don't work too much

Do everything to avoid exposure – But Live!

Find your way to defuse - Don't bottle it up


Exercise, R & R, Consider Meditation/Mindfulness

Stress is normal - Manage it - Keep Perspective

If you have warning signs: not sleeping/ † dreams & anxiety, anger, body signs, etc. – Get Help Stat Resources will be posted on PCC post & HIP



Map data @2020 Google, INEGI, ORION-ME






