





- 71% customized for local needs









## Supporting EMS Workforce During COVID-19

### **Developing the Strategy**

- What is the mandate of the work?
  - For our workforce to feel "cared for" to believe that their psychological wellness and safety is important to the organization
- Who needs to be involved?
  - Bring all the organizational stakeholders together to coordinate supports
- What are the known issues?
  - Self-isolating, lack of family support, mental health, caregiving challenges, stress management, regular consistent communication
- How do we keep the strategy relevant?
  - Rapid environment scan, theming, seek feedback, be responsive

## **Strategic Goals**

- Continuous assessment of workforce wellness challenges arising from COVID response
- Mitigate, where possible, workplace conflict, compassion fatigue, and burnout
- Facilitate workforce access to information and resources to increase feelings of community and support
- Ensure leadership has current consistent information on the supports available

### **Examples of Tactics**

- Social Media Community Support
- Webinar Support Forums
- Rapid Environmental Scan
- Enhanced Peer Support Network
- Organizational Approach to COVID-19 Related Deaths in the Workplace
- Enhanced collaboration with Joint Workplace Health committees
