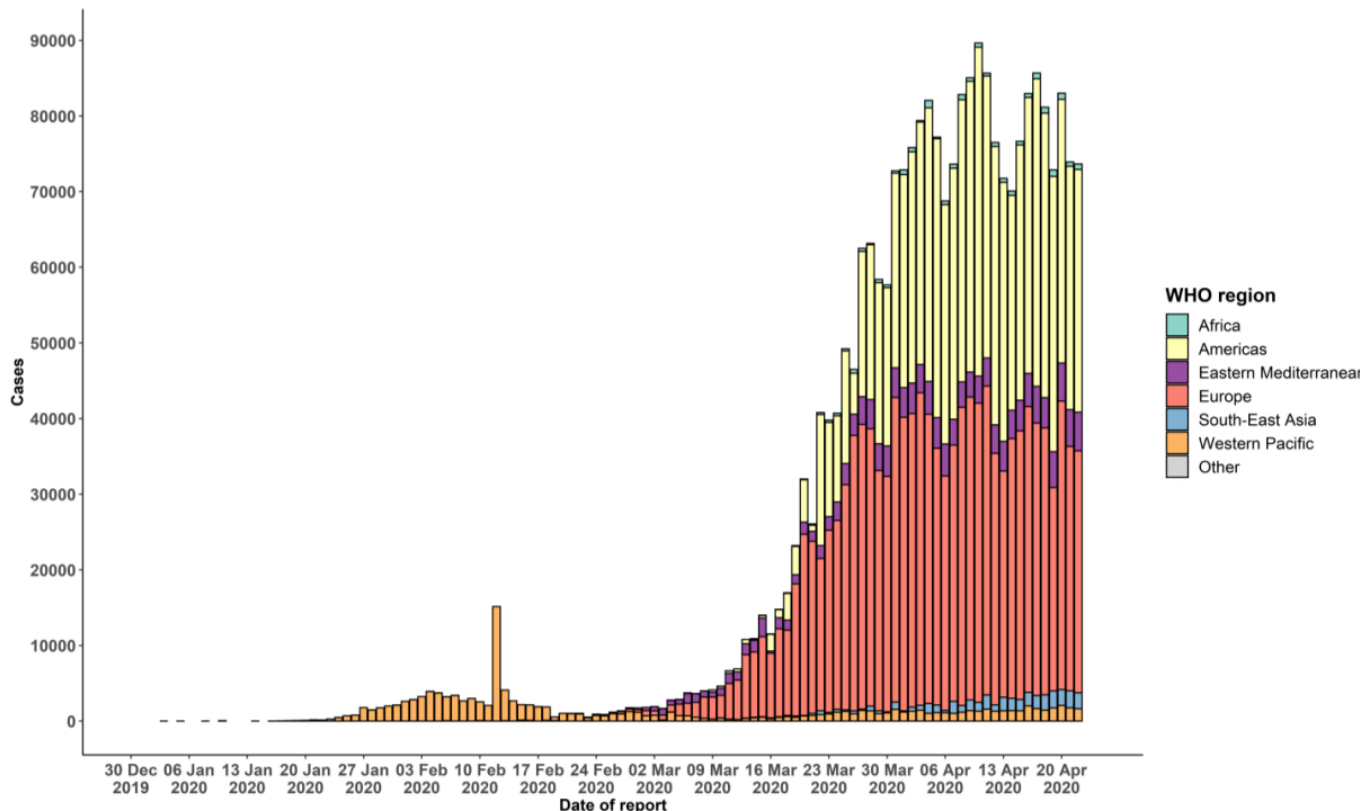

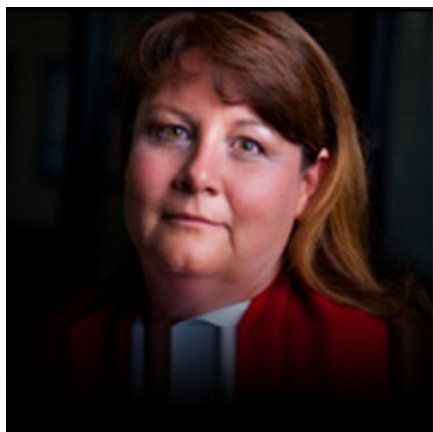

Decrease



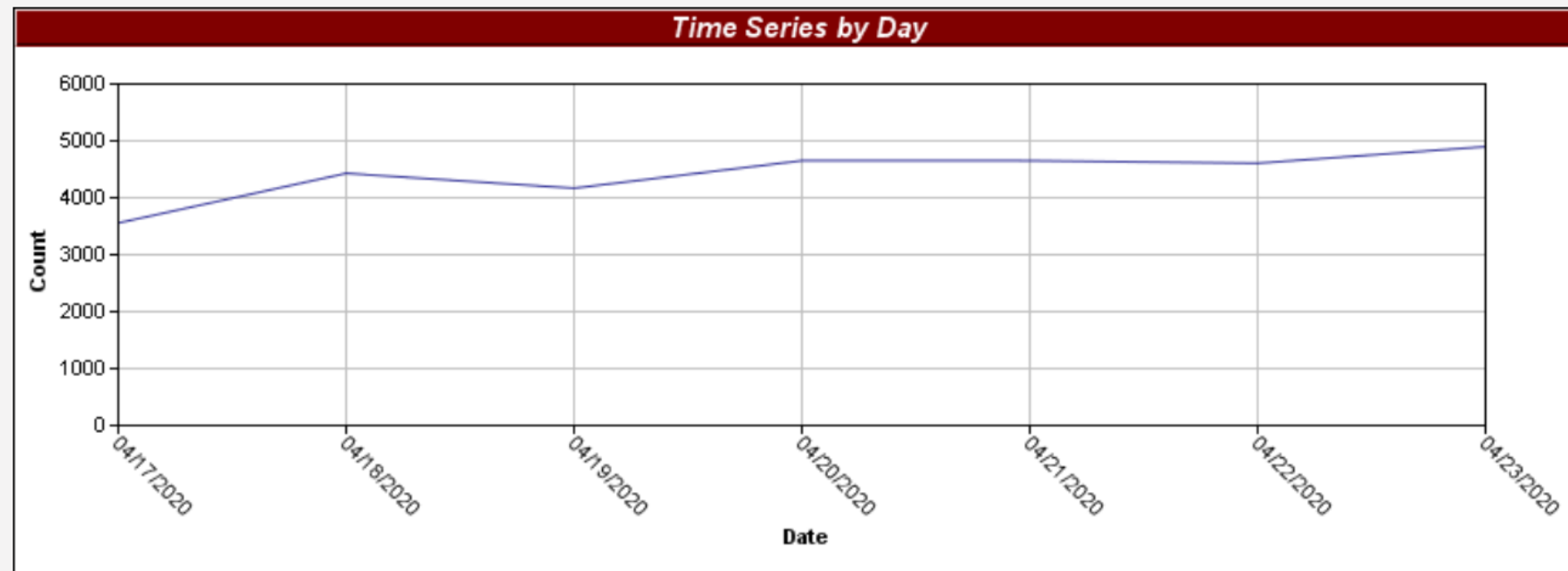

Bigger Picture



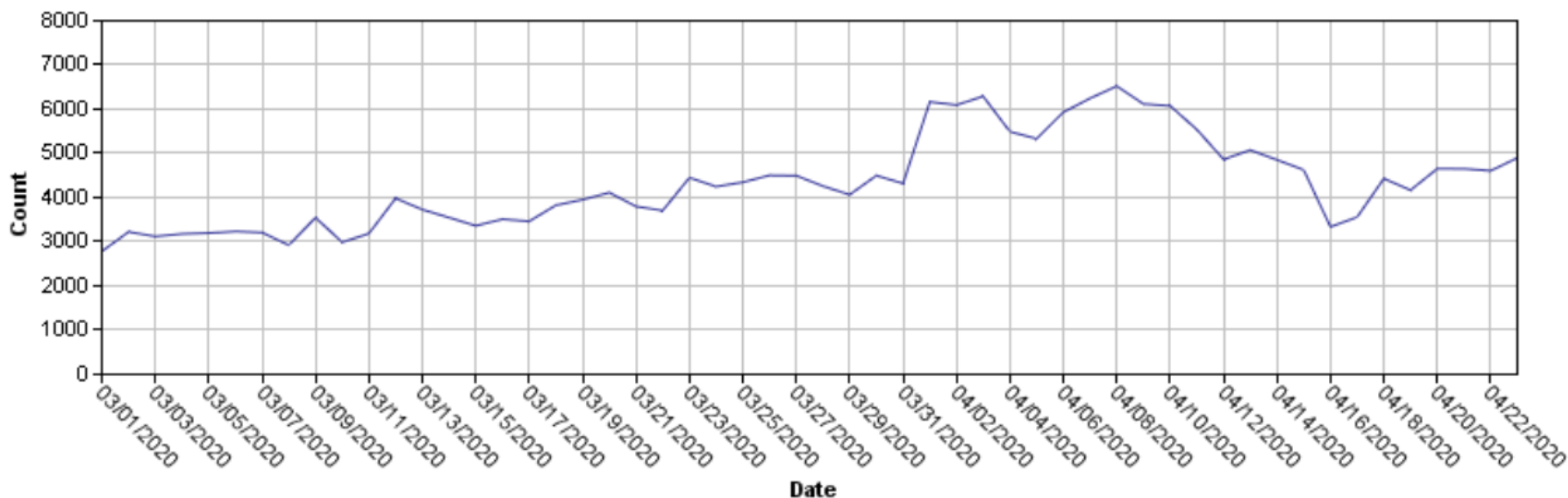

Time Series by Day

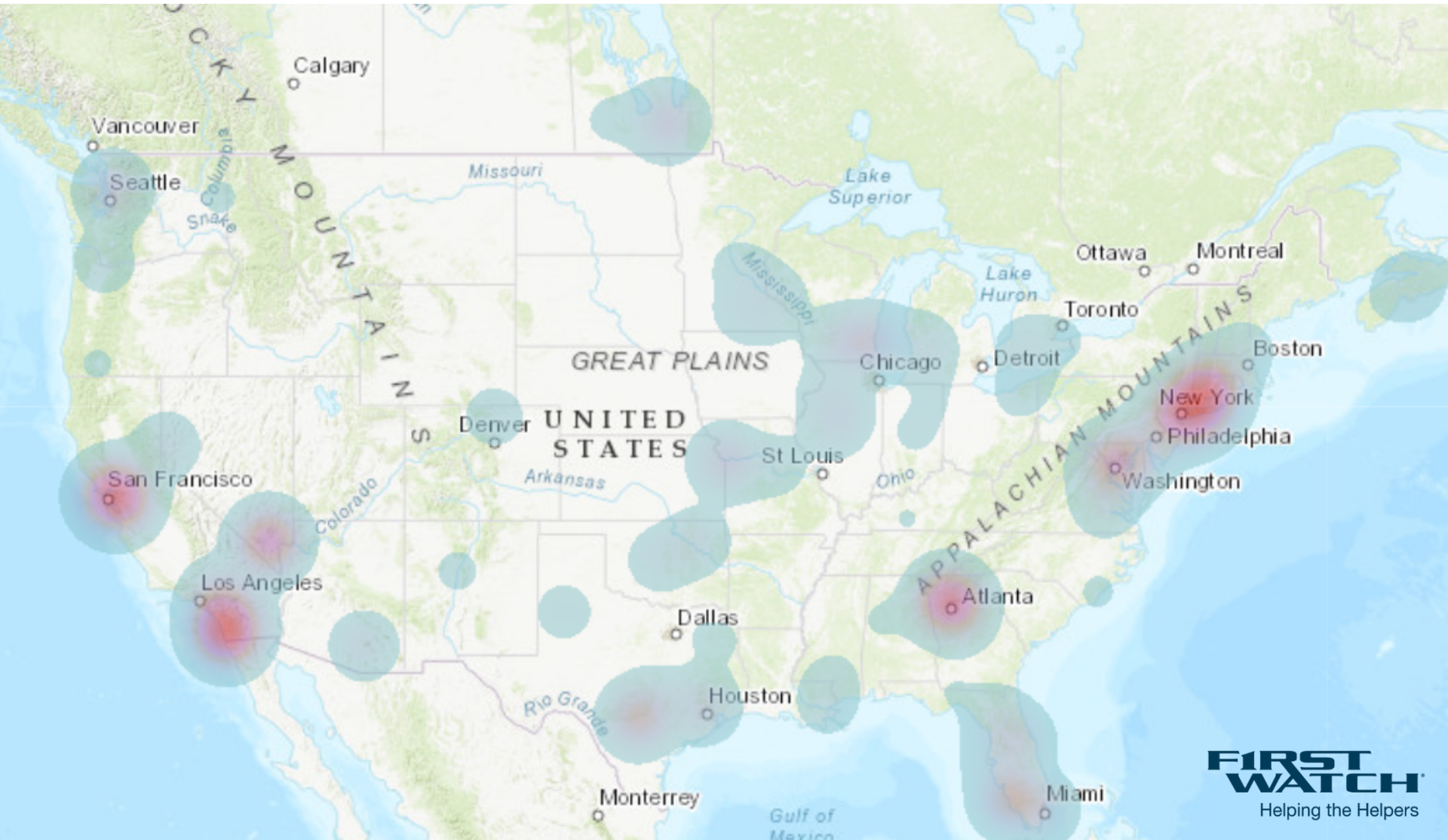
