





Trigger Count per Agency:



Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 4/17/2020 and 4/23/2020 11:59:59 PM






Graphs represent in queue, active or completed calls between the hours of 3/1/2020 and 4/23/2020 11:59:59 PM
