



Deaths - 3,386,825




Vaccine - 1,407,945,776




Deaths attributed to COVID 19








Total COVID – 19 cases in Canada


Date of illness onset



COVID-19 Update



- · It's been a long 16 months
- · With reason to hope for the end
- Canada & US are trending down
- · It's Vaccines vs Variants
- Maintain protections Stay Safe
- Encourage vaccinations ASAP

We Know Way More



- Scientists & Drs are working 24/7:
 - Clinical trials for preventatives & treatments
 - Sequencing COVID specimens for Variants
 - Pre and Post Peer Review Publishing
- Info has been shared like never before:
 - Podcasts & Vodcasts, Open Conferences & Meetings
 - Medical & Scientific Journals access FREE for COVID
 - Newspapers & Magazines also FREE access



- Aerosol
 - Acknowledged by WHO, CA & US in 2021
- Large Droplet
- Contaminated Surfaces (fomites)
 - Less common than expected but...

To Decrease Aerosol Risk



- N95 or better respirators: maintain masks indoors
- Improve Ventilation:
 - open windows
 - use fans
 - use HEPA or other high filtration
 - increase air exchanges

Aerosol Implications



Smaller & Lighter Particles:

- Linger longer (mins./hours)
- Ride air currents > 2-3 m (6-10 ft)
- Penetrate deeper (in lungs)
- Worse in poor ventilation
 - Inside
 - EMS trucks
- Crowded conditions

We Know More



Groups to Protect:

- Elderly
- Children (not yet immunized)
- Pregnant Women
- Can't be vaccinated (infants, allergic)
- Immunocompromised
 - Condition: cancer, incompetent immunity, sickle cell...
 - Treatment: immunosuppressants, chemo, radiation....
 - Procedure: all transplants, splenectomy......

Virus Variants



Viruses mutate to survive; Some will:

- Become them a non-threat
- Persist but NOT increase in virulence, transmissibility or escape from vaccines or treatments
- Change in how they transmit, an increase in severity, lethality, and/or escape vaccines or treatments

Therapeutics



- Remdesivir (antiviral)
- Monoclonal antibodies (before hospital)
- Hyperimmune globulin
- Anticoagulants
- Immunomodulators
- Other antivirals
 - Pfizer is in trials with an oral one


