Wednesday breakout sessions:

- 1. Fire Operations Analytics/Accreditation Module (FOAM): This module was created by experts in measurement and improvement and veterans of the fire service as an automated, near-real-time method of measuring and reporting a fire department's compliance with operational response time metrics in order to monitor performance, achieve and maintain CFAI accreditation, and assess the impact of changes to deployment models and other interventions. Additional functionality options include, conformance with ERF response goals and automated 3-axis risk models that can be used to determine or confirm current risk category models.
- 2. FirstPass: This clinical quality improvement system dramatically improves the QI function of any organization. Customized to your system's requirements, FirstPass helps you make meaningful improvements to the clinical care you provide.
- 3. From Dispatch to Hospital Using ProQA Data: Include ProQA data to analyze calls from call pickup to hospital drop off, and see the whole picture!
- 4. Getting Data Out of FirstWatch: Every once in a while you need to pull some data out of your FirstWatch system to do a quick analysis, create a chart for a report, or answer an urgent question.
